Multitasking: Executive Functioning in Dual-Task and Task Switching Situations Dec 16 2019

Multitasking refers to performance of multiple tasks. The most prominent types multitasking are situations including either temporal overlap of the execution of multip tasks (i.e., dual tasking) or executing multiple tasks in varying sequences (i.e., task swi In the literature, numerous attempts have aimed at theorizing about the specific characteristics of executive functions that control interference between simultaneous sequentially active component of task-sets in these situations. However, these approa have been rather vague regarding explanatory concepts (e.g., task-set inhibition, prepa shielding, capacity limitation), widely lacking theories on detailed mechanisms and/ or empirical evidence for specific subcomponents. The present research topic aims at pro selection of contributions on the details of executive functioning in dual-task and task

switching situations. The contributions specify these executive functions by focusing on (1) fractionating assumed mechanisms into constituent subcomponents, (2) their variation with age or in clinical subpopulations, and/ or (3) their plasticity as a response to practice training.

Explore the Function of KEL-8 in Oxidative Stress Response and Search for KEL-8 Interacting Proteins
Aug 24 2020 Previous work in our lab identified KEL-8, a BTB-Kelch superfamily protein, as a substrate receptor for a Cul3 ubiquitin ligase that plays a role in the turnover of GLR-1 AMPA-type glutamate receptors in neurons. *C. elegans* kel-8 is similar in sequence to Keap1, which encodes a BTB-Kelch protein that negatively regulates the oxidative stress response pathway, leading us to hypothesize that kel-8 is also involved in the oxidative stress response, repressing the expression of oxidative stress response genes. We have two major questions: what is the role of KEL-8 in oxidative stress and what are the targets of KEL-8. In order to answer the first question, we used the oxidative stress response transgene *Pgcs-1::gfp*. The *gcs-1* gene encodes a phase II detoxification enzyme, [gamma]-glutamine cysteine synthase, and is expressed in the intestine in response to oxidative stress reagents. I tested the expression level of *Pgcs-1::gfp* in *kel-8(od38)* null mutants and found that the *gcs-1* expression level in *kel-8* is constitutively high compared to wild-type animals. Our preliminary results indicate that KEL-8 functions similarly to Keap1 to repress the oxidative stress response. However, the repression phenotype is inconsistent. In addition, we did a yeast two-hybrid screen to search for targets or other interacting proteins of KEL-8, and we found 8 candidates. They are ZC434.8, *ric-4*, F32D8.12, *pccb-1*, *ssq-4*, *aly-3*, and *smo-1*. Further analyses need to be done to determine whether these are biologically meaningful interactions.

Artificial Immune Systems Jan 29 2021 Artificial immune systems (AIS) is a diverse and maturing area of research that bridges the disciplines of immunology and computation. The original research impetus in AIS had a clear focus on applying immunological principles to computational problems in practical domains such as computer security, data mining and optimization. As the field has matured, it has diversified such that we now see a growing interest in formalizing the theoretical properties of earlier approaches, elaborating underlying relationships between applied computational models and those from theoretical immunology, as well as a return to the roots of the domain in which the methods of computer science are being applied to immunological modelling problems. From Basal Lymphocyte Motility to Peripheral Tissue Immune Response 2021 The application of video-rate two-photon imaging to the study of the immune system has revolutionized the field of immunology, allowing for the behavior of individual lymphocytes in living tissues to be assessed in real time. Prior to in vivo imaging of T and B cell behavior, the means by which a rare antigen specific cell could find and respond to cognate antigen in living tissues enough to prevent the demise of the organism were unknown. The rapid mean three dimensional velocity of T cells (16 microns per minute) and B cells (8 microns per minute) in their respective lymphoid compartments affords a plausible mechanism by which cells can rapidly search for cognate antigen retained and presented by local APCs.

Adaptive Search Behavior Jan 09 2022 When an interactive search system returns a result list that fails to meet its user's information need, the user experiences a query failure. In the present generation of search systems, except for the most common and simple information needs, users often encounter query failure. This dissertation examined the behaviors that searchers use when overcoming query failure. Specifically, this dissertation compared searchers' behaviors when conducting searches on systems operating at three different levels of performance in a mixed-model factorial experiment, with system performance as the independent variable. A General Linear Model and planned contrasts were used in an exploratory analysis of the effects of system performance on system responses, search behavior, and searcher

productivity. Thirty-six volunteers from the Rutgers University community participated in the study. The study found that when system performance is degraded, searchers increase the pace of query submissions. Inter-query time intervals are shorter when results lists are displayed and when a spelling error message is displayed with a results list. These findings suggest that a system capable of monitoring a user's query submission rate and the characteristics of their own responses may be able to detect and assist a user experiencing a difficult search.
